#### Introduction:

Curriculum and syllabus for Advanced Practice Midwives are structured following the requirements from the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing & Midwifery Manual for Program Planning and Examination (May 2021). The advanced midwifery certification program consists of three major components including the generic core, advanced practice core and specialty core with at least 60% structured courses offered at the post-graduate level and the remaining not more than 40% structured courses provided by specialty course providers.

In order to meet the competencies required of an Advanced Practice Midwife, mentee has to complete at least 500 theoretical hours in advanced midwifery practice certification program, with a minimum of 300 hours at postgraduate level and the remaining hours being recognized by the College as following curriculum and syllabus of subject requirement during the four years of membership training.
