Committees Report

Education Committee:

Over the last year, Education Committee worked hard on the membership training framework. Eight committee meetings had been held from September 2013 to May 2014. Three work groups were formed to work on membership training framework and assessment criteria. Flow Chart of Membership Training Framework had been drafted. Clinical Log Book for the Module 2 – Post-basic Midwifery Management had been developed and was endorsed by the Council in May 2014. Clinical Log Book for Module 3 (higher specialty training) - the “Midwives-led Care” was under development. Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) Panel was formed to develop the MCQ Bank for the Full Membership Examination.

Education Committee worked with Professional Development Committee was successfully granted 3 years accreditation as PEM provider by the Midwives Council of Hong Kong.

Fellowship Selection Committee

With a stringent selection process by the Fellowship selection committee, three cohorts of midwives were nominated by Hong Kong College of Midwives (HKCM) and successfully admitted as Fellow Member under the Grandfather Fellowship Scheme of Provisional Hong Kong Academy of Nursing (PHKAN) since 2012. In 2012, 50 out of 131 applicants were successfully admitted. In 2013, 69 out of 153 applicants were successful, with one applicant to be conferred in 2014. In 2014, 79 out of 96 applicants were successful; together with one successful applicant from last year, a total 80 fellows had been conferred this year.

Finance and Executive Committee

The 1st Election of Members of Council 2013/2015 was completed in May 2013. The second Council was set up with 7 Office Bearers, 6 Council Members and 8 Co-opt Members. The seeding fund of HK\$100,000 on loan from the Hong Kong Midwives Association was returned in April 2014.

The HKCM has continuously appointed Mr. Sam CHU as the Legal Advisor and Mr. Eddie KAM as the Auditor. Dr Lawrence TANG has kindly accepted our invitation to continue be the Honorary Advisor.

Up to June 2014, the total number of Fellows admitted was 191. There are 45 and 66 Fellows of the first and second cohort had renewed their membership in April 2014. Both the application fee and renewal fee for Fellow membership are remained the same at HK\$2000.

The Financial status of the College remained healthy and the annual statement was attached for your reference (Appendix I).
